### Description

Stick: round; pernambuco Frog: ebony; silver ferrule and heel-plate; nickel-silver lining; abalone eyes, highly figured abalone slide; silver pin in heel-plate on underside of frog; two silver pins through heel plate near slide on bottom; one silver pin near stick at back of heel; one metal pin through lining in front of eyelet; rounded heel Adjuster: ebony covered in silver Tip plate: ebony-lined silver; two silver pins each in front of and behind mortise Wrapping: silver Grip: black leather
