### Description

Stick: round; pernambuco Frog: ebony; silver ferrule and heel-plate; nickel-silver lining; abalone eyes surrounded by silver rings (Parisian eyes), highly figured abalone slide; silver pin in heel-plate on underside of frog; two overlapping silver pins in heelplate at back of frog near stick; nickel-silver pin through lining into frog behind eyelet; rounded heel Adjuster: ebony with two silver rings; silver pins in one facet of each ring; abalone eye Tip plate: ebony-lined silver; two silver pins each in front of and

behind mortise Wrapping: silver Grip: black leather
