4 sections: barrel, top joint, bottom joint, and bell. Grenadilla wood body with nickel-silver keywork and ferrules. "Albert" system with 15 touchpieces and 6 ring keys. Wrap-around register key. Articulated G-sharp key. Pupeschi key. Patent C-sharp. Features US Patent #623, 422 from April 18, 1899 (applied for).
