## Description

4 sections: barrel, top joint, bottom joint, and bell. Darkwood body with nickel-silver ferrules and keywork. Ebonite bell. Van Perck system with 16 keys and 4 rings. Pre-Boehm simple system with Barret action (F/C, E-flat/B-flat side key articulated with rings) on top joint. Long tailed individual G-sharp key. Wrap-around-front register key. Side trill key for G-sharp/C. Late alternate Boehm system on bottom joint, in which lowest keys (low E/B, F-sharp/C-sharp, and F/C) are duplicated. Patent C-sharp mechanism.
